



Podcast – Research Project

A podcast is a digital audio file that is shared to people across the Internet. They are usually in the form of series, with episodes, and usually involve multiple individuals discussing about a variety of topics. If you are doing your podcast alone, then you can think of it as an “audio-documentary” just like the one that you listened to for your Nueva York assignment.

What I am expecting from you for this assignment is that:

-You present a research project of your choice that

a) engages with a topic we explored in class but gives a little spin to it

Example.... we studied jazz, but what about “women in jazz”

or...

b) presents a brand new topic about music, diasporic communities, etc.

In your podcast you should:

- 1) Give background information about your topic....
 - Why should anyone care about it?
 - How does it relate to the topics we have been exploring in class?
 - Some history about this phenomenon
- 2) What is the main thing you are exploring about this? (explain)
 - and what are other things we should know?
- 3) Provide musical examples!
 - (and explain what they are about or why are they important)
- 4) Concluding thoughts
 - Summary of what you presented



- Things you didn't get to talk about/do research on
- Some interesting questions for someone to continue doing research on this?

Your podcast should be at least 10 minutes long, including musical examples. Try not to make it longer than 20 minutes.

It is due May 14

You then have a week to do a small write up about your research process and to reflect on the comments that your classmates and I share about your podcast.

These are some programs or apps for editing audio for free.

You can record things on the mic of your phone or your computer.

- Audacity is my top choice. It is free, very complete for what you need and easy to use.
