

Album/Record Review Assignment (Blog *blessay*): This assignment requires students to write a review of an album or record. The review should be a blend of academic analysis and personal reflection, in the style of a "blessay" (a term coined by Prof. Dan Cohen to describe a piece of writing that is between a blog post and an essay).

• Guidelines:

- Selection of Album/Record: Choose an album or record that offers enough material for a detailed review. This could be a classic album, a recent release, or an overlooked gem.
- o Length: The review should be between 1,000 and 1,500 words.
- o **Content**: The review should include both an analysis of the music (considering elements such as melody, harmony, rhythm, lyrics, production, etc.) and a personal reflection on the album's impact or significance.
- o **References**: Please, include a works cited where you cite at least two (2) secondary sources and two (2) popular reception sources. Any external sources used should be properly cited.

• Tips:

- Understanding of the Album/Record: Does the review demonstrate a deep understanding of the album, its various elements, and its impact or significance?
- o **Depth of Analysis**: Does the review go beyond surface-level observations to provide insight into the album's musical and lyrical content?
- **Personal Reflection**: Does the review include a thoughtful personal reflection on the album's impact or significance?
- o Writing Quality: Is the review well-written, with clear and concise prose?
- **Organization**: Is the review well-organized, with a clear introduction, body, and conclusion?
